## Parking & Driving

With more children walking to and from school these days and a few incidents being mentioned to me, please take extra care when driving on the estate. Please be respectful to our neighbours when picking up and dropping off your children. **Please don't park over the white line markings by the dropped kerb at the end of Beechwood Lane**. Parking here is classed as causing an obstruction and you may be issued with either a Penalty Charge Notice (by the local council) or a Fixed Penalty Notice (by the police).

This makes it very difficult and dangerous for people to cross, thus endangering the children. In addition, please do not park on the white lines outside properties in the surrounding roads.

Parking across the yellow zig-zag lines outside our gates and in the entrance to the former Huffle site may also be classed as an obstruction.

A polite reminder that we discourage cars from driving on to the school premises at all times and that NO cars should enter between 8.30 and 9.00 am, and between 3.00 and 3.30 pm for the safety of the children.
